WEIGH IN

The weigh in for the event will take place between 1800 and 2000 hours on Friday 1st October 2010 within the Newburgh Suite, Double Tree Hotel.

An additional weigh in on the Saturday morning may be granted on request and at the discretion of the organising committee and Competition Controller.

FIRST AID

First Aid for the duration of the event will be covered by the British Red Cross. All staff within the Sports Village are also First aid trained.

ARRIVAL

The Double Tree Hotel, Beach Boulevard, Aberdeen is a 4 star hotel with many facilities including health and fitness area, sauna, pool etc. It is less than a mile from Aberdeen City Centre and about 7 miles from Aberdeen Airport. There is a regular bus service into the city and transport will be available between hotel and competition venue.

Competitors, officials and guests are requested to arrive at the hotel between 1400 and 1800 hours, where you will be welcomed by the committee. Rooms will be available from 1400 hours on the Friday. Rooms have to be vacated by 1000 hours on the Sunday.

If required, competitors will be met by prior arrangement and conveyed to the hotel from Aberdeen Railway Station or Airport. Any competitor or official requiring transport is requested to submit a "Transport request form" ensuring that an e-mail address is included in order that the organisers are able to notify you of the vehicles that will be collecting you. (A separate form is required for each person requesting transport)

ENTRY PACKAGE

The accommodation has been arranged on a block booking basis for competitors, officials and guests on a **weekend package** basis, which is inclusive of two night's bed and breakfast, a buffet dinner on the Friday evening, packed lunch at the Sports Village and presentation dinner on the Saturday. Due to the competitive rates that we have obtained from the hotel we are unable to provide any reduction for any guests only wishing to stay for one night.

The entry and accommodation package price (including meals and presentation dinner) of £205 is based on two persons sharing a twin or double bedded room.

For non competitors the package price is £165 based on two persons sharing a twin or double bedded room.

Single occupancy rooms will cost a supplement of £60 for the weekend.

The cost of the Presentation Dinner only on Saturday for guests and non-residents will be £40.00 and will be within the Balmedie suite.

Accommodation costs will be settled by the Organising Committee direct with the hotel.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Any special needs, dietary or otherwise, must be mentioned on the accommodation form.

NOT INCLUDED

We ask that all extras such as newspapers, bar bills and telephone calls are settled by the guests prior to departure as they are not included in the above costs.

PARKING

There is adequate free parking at the Double Tree Hotel but spaces are limited at the Sports Village.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

The event will be run on a Pools/Knockout/Repêchage system in accordance with International Judo Federation Rules. In the event of dispute, the Tournament Director's decision is final.

ELIGIBILITY

Competitors are entitled to participate provided they are members of affiliated clubs in accordance with the provisions of the Police Sport UK Constitution. All competitors **must** hold a current British Judo Association Licence (or associated organisations) entitling them to compete in BJA events. Competitors will not be allowed to compete if they cannot produce a licence at the weigh-in or on the day of the competition. There will be no facilities to purchase BJA licences on the day. This is in accordance with BJA and Police Sport UK rules.

Competitors may enter a maximum of **two categories** for which they are eligible. Competitors may enter the Men's Open, Ladies Open and Kyu grade Open on the day. Kyu grade competitors who have won Gold in the PSUK Championship in each of the last two years will not be eligible to compete in the kyu grade event and must enter the open event, veterans or masters (or combination of two).

COMPETITION DRAW

The pool sheets will be completed on the Saturday morning and will be seeded from the results of the previous year's competition and then on grade.

JUDO ITINERARY

Friday 1 October 2010.

1400hrs onwards - Arrive at The Double Tree (by Hilton), Beach Boulevard, Aberdeen, AB24 5EF

Directions:

Heading North on A90, exit onto A956 Wellington Road (signposted Aberdeen Harbour), continue to follow A956 and go through 3 roundabouts, cross Victoria Bridge and at the next roundabout take the third exit onto North Esplanade West/A956, follow road and bare left onto Market street, about 0.5 mile then turn right onto Virginia street, follow road and turn left at Commerce street. At the roundabout take the 5th exit onto the Beach Boulevard, turn left onto Links road and the hotel is on the right.

1800 – 2000hrs - Weigh in at the Newburgh Suite in Hotel

1830 hrs onwards - Meal in the Balmedie Suite at hotel (Pre paid only)

0830 – 0930hrs

Supplementary weigh in at the hotel (Newburgh Suite). This weigh in is only offered by prior arrangement due to duty commitments etc at the tournament directors discretion. There will be one opportunity to weigh in only and all competitors weighing in on Saturday will not have time to run weight off etc.
