



# Police Sport UK National Judo Championships Hosted by North Wales Police 10<sup>th</sup> October 2009

The 2009 Police Sport UK National Judo Championships will be held in the Sports Facility at Deeside College, Connah's Quay, Flintshire on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2009. Competitors should arrive on the afternoon of Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2009. Accommodation has been arranged at The De Vere, St David's Park, Ewloe, nr Chester. Accommodation has been arranged on a twin room basis for 2 nights. A limited number of single rooms are available at the single room occupancy rate. The hotel has the usual facilities including a gym, pool, sauna etc. Competitors are encouraged to bring guests with them on appropriate payment.

This is the first occasion that the Police Sport UK Judo Championships have been hosted by North Wales Police and the organising committee is endeavouring to make this a memorable event. It is therefore hoped that all Forces will give their support by encouraging as many competitors as possible to attend the Championships and remain for the presentation dinner.

You are requested to complete the enclosed documentation detailing entrants and accommodation requirements on behalf of your competitors and guests. Separate invitations will be forwarded to National Sporting Sectional Committee Members.

### **Eligibility:**

Competitors are entitled to participate provided they are members of affiliated clubs in accordance with the provisions of Rule 39 of the Police Sport UK Constitution. All competitors must hold a current British Judo Association Licence (or associated organisations) entitling them to compete in BJA events. Competitors will not be allowed to compete if they cannot produce a licence at the weigh-in or on the day of the competition. There will be no facilities to purchase BJA licences on the day. This is in accordance with BJA and Police Sport UK rules.

Competitors may enter a maximum of **two categories** for which they are eligible. The event will be run on a Pools/Knockout/Repéchage system in accordance with International Judo Federation Rules. In the event of dispute, the Tournament Director's decision is final.

The entry form, together with composite fees, must be forwarded to the Organising Committee not later than **1<sup>st</sup> September 2009**.

# **JUDO ITINERARY**

## **Friday 9 October 2009.**

**1500hrs onwards** - Arrive at De Vere St David's Park hotel, Ewloe, **CH5 3YB**.

### **Directions:**

M6, M56 for North Wales, A5117 for North Wales, A494 past Queensferry, then take the B5125 signposted Hawarden and the Hotel is located on the roundabout

**1800 – 2000hrs** - Weigh in at the Raglan Boardroom in Hotel

**2000hrs onwards** - Meal in the St.David's Suite at hotel (Pre paid only)

There will be one opportunity to weigh in only and all competitors weighing in on Saturday will not have time to run weight off etc.

### **Directions from hotel to venue:**

At bottom of hill branch left (signposted Queensferry) then at roundabout take 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto B5129. Deeside College will be found on the left hand side after 3 miles. Turn left inside the entrance gate and follow road around to car park at rear of building (Follow signs for Lifestyle Fitness)
